CHARGES FOR OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT THE 2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Charges apply for the provision of extra cost optional activities that are part of an education program and which *voluntary contributions* do not cover. All activities outlined below are optional and if no payment is received, an alternative educational activity will be provided for your child.

The School Board has approved all 2024 extra cost optional activities. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed the amount shown. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.

Payment of the following charges is not required at the same time of finalising payment of voluntary contributions; staff will request payment prior to the event happening

through a note to parents.
